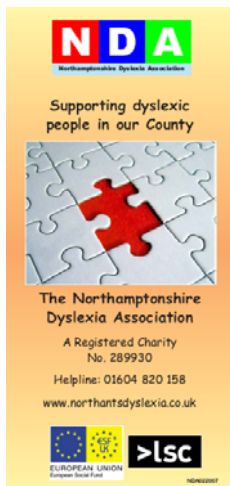

How to find an assessor for Dyslexia



The Northants Dyslexia Association has a list of specialist teachers who are qualified to assess adults and can help you to find a psychologist if required.

You may get a free assessment if:

- A GP [doctor] refers you to a chartered clinical psychologist when it is considered dyslexia is affecting your health, e.g. causing undue stress.
- If dyslexia is an issue at work or when you are looking for a job you should consult the Disability Employment Advisor [DEA] at your local Job Centre.
- Students may find there is a system for assessment within their college or university's student support service team.

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
