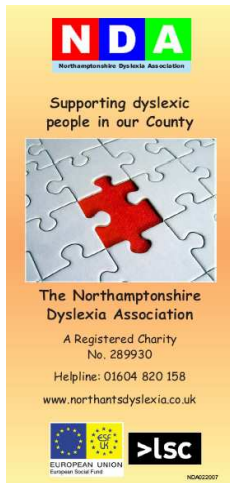




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Dyslexia: Frequently Asked Questions

INCA FAQ No.10: What kind of help might I be able to get for my child at school?

All schools should be making reasonable adjustments for those students who require these arrangements.

All schools are encouraged to be dyslexia friendly and to promote dyslexia friendly classrooms. The DfES provides guidance to schools to help them.

Differentiation in the classroom would be considered as a Wave 1 provision.

For those children who are not making appropriate progress it would be good practice to move to a Wave 2 provision of support that would include small group work.

If appropriate progress is still not being made the child could be taught one-to-one - that is Wave 3 support.
