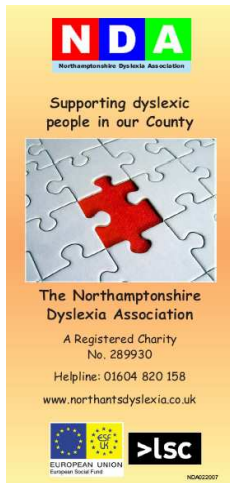

### INCA FAQ No.5:

### When does dyslexia become a problem?

Usually when a child begins to use words and then begins to read, dyslexia may be noticed. Often a parent or teacher will realise that the child is not doing as well as the rest of the class.

Dyslexic people of all ages may learn to manage their dyslexia very well but it can become a problem when there is a significant (to them) change in their daily life, for example, at work when there is a new requirement to read and prepare reports; in children when moving between schools, other stressful events.
