

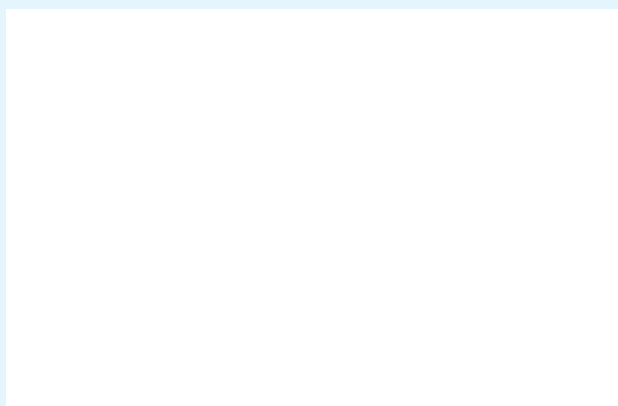

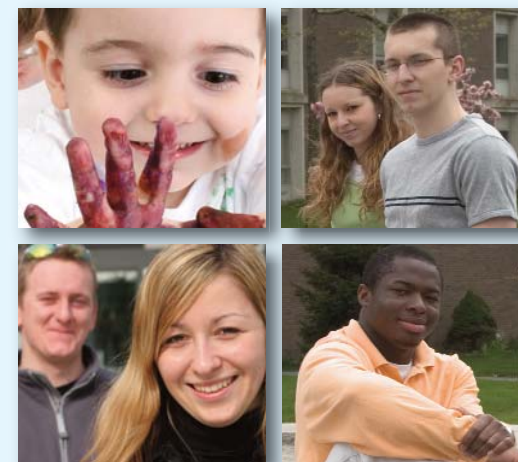

- At least 10% of the population with some level of dyslexia
- And of them, 4% will be severely affected by dyslexia.
- So at some time we will all come across the effects of dyslexia.

Why is our work so vital?

Because so many people do not understand dyslexia, what it takes to manage dyslexia, to develop abilities.

This can lead to underachievement at school and at work. It can lead to unfair treatment and bullying. Yet it need not be like this.
