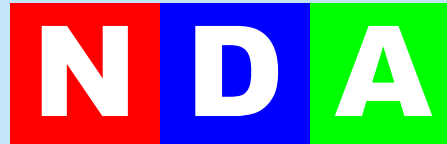

NDA has a list of local specialist tutors who can work with children in their own home to support school learning.

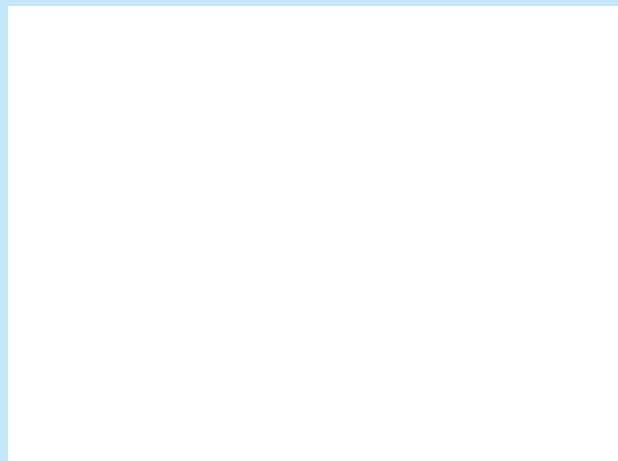

Dyslexia affects almost everyone in our community, not just those with dyslexia. Research suggests there are:

- At least 10% of the population with some level of dyslexia
- And of them, 4% will be severely affected by Dyslexia.
- So at some time we will all come across the effects of Dyslexia.

Importantly, because of the many abilities often enhanced in dyslexics, there is a positive impact of dyslexia, consider the work of these dyslexics:

Why is our work so vital?

Because so many people do not understand dyslexia, what it takes to manage dyslexia, to develop abilities.

This can lead to underachievement at school and at work. It can lead to unfair treatment and bullying. Yet it need not be like this.
